NUSS ORGANISES PRE-GENERAL ELECTION FORUM

The National University of Singapore Society continues its tradition of hosting a Pre-GE Forum where all political parties are invited

3 July 2020 – The National University of Singapore Society (NUSS) will host a Pre-General Election (GE) Forum on Friday, 3 July 2020 at 7pm to provide a platform for political party representatives to share their views and objectives with NUSS members.

NUSS Pre-GE Forum 2020 follows the success of the previous Pre-GE Forums it organised in the lead up to the general elections in 2015, 2011 and 2006 which saw a good turnout of political party representatives and audience comprising NUSS members.

To abide by the authorities' safe management guidelines given the prevailing COVID-19 situation, NUSS Pre-GE Forum 2020 will be live-streamed to NUSS members. With Mothership.sg as a media partner, the Pre-GE Forum will also be streamed over its social media channel.

NUSS has invited all registered political parties in Singapore to be part of the panel. A list of political party representatives who are participating at the Forum is included in Annex A.

Each political party representative on the panel will be allocated 10 minutes to present, followed by a Question and Answer segment. NUSS members who pre-registered for the online event will also get the opportunity to pose questions during the Question and Answer segment.

NUSS' long-standing member and former Nominated Member of Parliament Mr Viswa Sadasivan will be the moderator. Mr Sadasivan is also the host of Inconvenient Questions, a series of one-on-one interviews with interesting newsmakers and political party representatives, organised by Strategic Moves in collaboration with NUSS.

As the foremost graduate society, NUSS promotes the interests of all stakeholders by providing appropriate platforms for all to exchange ideas through cultural, intellectual and social activities.
